- Providing strong and visible advocacy for and contributing to the formulation and support of public policies that promote optimal health equity
- Promoting inclusion of knowledge about health equity and social determinants of health in all CBHA trainings and programs as well as external institutions including Pre-K to 12, undergraduate, graduate, training programs, continuing education, and professional development of clinical staff.
- Develop and disseminate information concerning the scientific findings and practice implications of health equity issues.
