## **AB 988 Legislation**

### The Miles Hall Lifeline and Suicide Prevention Act enacted September 2022:

- Creates the 988 State Suicide and Behavioral Health Crisis Services Fund via surcharges on telecom per access line per month
- Requires the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) to convene a state <u>988 Technical Advisory Board</u>
- Requires CalHHS to convene a state 988 policy advisory group (<u>988-Crisis Policy Advisory Group</u>) to advise on a set of recommendations for the five-year implementation plan for a comprehensive 988 system by December 31, 2024
  - AB 988 underwent further modifications in <u>AB 118</u>, the trailer bill that incorporates the implementing language of the California State Budget.
  - Requires CalHHS to post regular updates, no less than annually, regarding the implementation of 988 on its public internet website, until December 31, 2029
