Youth Homelessness Data

- California Department of Education
16k+ homeless youth | 400+ unsheltered youth
- Homeless Data Integration System
1.1k+ homeless youth | 3.5k+ families with Children
- Point In Time Count
200+ homeless youth | 12+ parenting youth





Homelessness Funding

- Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention (HHAP) program funding allocation
\$74.8 Million | \$7.48 Million youth set-aside MINIMUM.
- HomeKey Rounds Two | Three
\$26.9 Million | \$31 Million | 10% youth set-aside MINIMUM.
